- a) Define the term *metadata* in its widest sense in the context of digital resources. Explain what a metadata record is made up of and where it may be found.
- b) Explain and give the significance of the following **THREE** (3) standards for the creation and management of metadata: *data value*; data *content*; *encoding*. Use examples to support your answer.
- c) Explain the difference between the elements *Creator* and *Contributor* in Dublin Core Metadata Element Set (DCMES).

- 2. Answer **ALL** parts of this question.
- a) Explain FOUR (4) functions of metadata for digital resources and for each give TWO(2) elements that perform that function.
- b) Explain the terms <u>granularity</u> and <u>repeatability</u>, indicating their significance in the context of metadata for resource discovery. Discuss how each affects the function of a given element, using examples.
- c) Explain the term *property-value pair* and give two examples one of which must be in XML coding.

- 3. Explain what an element set is and why there is such a variety of them. Describe the main features of the Dublin Core Metadata Element Set (DCMES) then discuss two strengths and two weaknesses.
- 4. a) Elaborate on **THREE** (3) reasons for the importance of standardization as it relates to searching for resources in a digital collection.
- b) Describe the **FOUR (4)** types of controlled vocabularies typically used in metadata element sets to achieve standardization. Explain which elements typically use any **TWO** (2) of them, giving examples.
- 5. a) Briefly explain the purpose of digital collection management software.
- b) Write an assessment of *Greenstone Digital Library* Software using any **FIVE** (5) features you would expect to find in a digital collection management software.
- 6. Explain the **SIX** (6) steps in designing a metadata scheme as recommended by Stephen J. Miller in *Metadata for Digital Collections*, and elaborate on any **FOUR** (4) steps.
