



FINDING NEWSPAPER ARTICLES AT THE UWI MONA LIBRARY

THE GLEANER

For articles from October 28, 1998 – present:-

1. Visit the Gleaner's website at www.go-jamaica.com
2. Scroll down and click on "Search Archives" to the left of the screen.
3. Type in keywords based on the type of information you need e.g. tourism, child abuse etc.
4. Click "Find".
5. Click on any of the results to view the article in full-text
6. Remember to note the author, title, date of the Gleaner, web address and the date you accessed the article.

Print copies are also available in the Periodicals Section-Main Library.

For articles from 1974-1998:-

1. Consult The Gleaner Index, located at call number **AI21 A5** on the Periodicals floor.
2. Search these indexes by month and/or year by looking for keywords based on the type of information you need e.g. tourism, child abuse etc.
3. Remember to note the author, title and date of the Gleaner.
4. Locate the Gleaner in print or microfilm from the Periodicals Section or West Indies Collection respectively.

For articles prior to 1974:-

1. These have not been indexed, so you would need to browse through the issues.
2. Visit the West Indies Collection and request a particular issue of the Gleaner e.g. August 1962. *Note that these are all on microfilm.*
3. Remember to note the author, title and date of the Gleaner.

THE JAMAICA OBSERVER

1. Visit the Jamaica Observer's website at <http://jamaicaobserver.com>
2. Look for the "Search Archives" to the left of the screen.
3. Type in keywords based on the type of information you need e.g. tourism, child abuse etc.
4. Click "Go".
5. Click on any of the results to view the article in full-text.
6. You can also return to the homepage to do an "Advanced Search" by a particular category or section.
7. Remember to note the author, title, date of the Observer, web address and the date you accessed the article.

Print copies are also available in the Periodicals Office-Main Library.
