

The Global Index within the Caribbean

Caribbean Open Institute (COI) has participated in Expert Surveys for the Global Index for Responsible AI (GIRAI), which was designed to equip governments, civil society, and stakeholders with the evidence needed to advance rights-based principles for the responsible use of AI. The Global Index, funded by IDRC, the Government of Canada, and USAID, currently measures progress on the responsible use of AI in over 140 countries.

Within the Caribbean, COI's research team spearheaded by Dr. Maurice McNaughton, Director of Excellence at MSBM, was assembled to undertake data collection efforts and analysis. This team comprised of nine researchers spanning across the region. Moving forward, the team will attend the Caribbean Al Conference hosted by The UWI Five Islands Campus in Antigua to launch the Caribbean GIRAI findings and discuss implications for Governance and Capacity-building. The GIRAI Initiative has been recognized in UNESCO's International Research Centre on Artificial Intelligence (IRCAI) global list of top 100 Al projects. The Flagship GIRAI Report will be launched in London in June 2024. **Read More**

Jamaica one of two Caribbean countries in World Economic Forum's Groundbreaking 'Future of Growth Report'

In 2023 the World Economic Forum (WEF) announced a strategic shift in its publication approach, discontinuing the Global Competitiveness Report in favor of two new flagship reports: the "Global Risk Report" and the "Future of Growth Report".

The Global Competitiveness Report (GCR), published between 2004 and 2020, relies on the results of an Executive Opinion Survey, completed by at least 80 companies per country, which has been administered in Jamaica by Mona School of Business & Management (MSBM). Read more
