FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc. Engineering)

Three Years Full-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics AND two double Units CAPE or 2 GCE A'Level passes in Pure/Pure & Applied Mathematics and Physics OR equivalent qualifications from an approved tertiary institution. Biology at any level could be an advantage for Biomedical Engineering.

Note: Holders of associate degrees or diplomas from approved Caribbean tertiary level institutions must possess a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.5 or 65% and above.

FACULTY OF HUMANITIES & EDUCATION

(Education-Based) B.Ed.

Three Years (without Teacher Training) Full-Time

(Options: Computer Science/ Information Technology, History, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies/Geography, Language Education: English Language and Language Education: Literacy Studies)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) including English Language AND two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A'Level subjects in relevant area.
- Two Years (Teacher Trained) Full-Time or Three Years Part-Time. Must possess Teachers' College Certificate in relevant area + 4 CXC grades (I-III)/ GCE (A-C) including English Language.

OF

- Multi-Modal/In-Service Study- in any of the following disciplines: Mathematics Education, English Language Education, Science Education and Social Studies/Geography Education.
- Must be employed at the secondary level in the desired area of study and possess a Teachers' College Diploma in relevant area + CSEC/ GCE O'Level English Language and 3 other CSEC subjects.

(Humanities-Based) (B.A.)

Three Years Full-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level / BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) including English Language AND two
double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A'Level subjects (one of which must be a Humanities subject for which courses are taught at the
University). A pass in a foreign language, at least at the CSEC Level/O'Level, is recommended.

Four Years Part-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) including English Language. A pass in a foreign language, at least at the CSEC Level/O'Level, is recommended.

Diploma Programmes

- Diploma in Caribbean Sign Language Interpreting (full-time & part-time) 5 CSEC passes or equivalent
 including English. Involvement in a deaf community is an asset. (A degree is not required).
- Diploma in Media and Communications (full-time & part-time). Must have experience in relevant area of interest. (The UWI Mona-Western Jamaica Campus only).

FACULTY OF LAW

Bachelor of Laws (LL.B)

Three Years Full-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language
 AND two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A'Level (passes with highly competitive grades) OR an associate degree from an approved
 tertiary level institution with a GPA of 2.5 and above OR
- A bachelor's or master's degree from an approved university.



FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

(B.Sc.

Three Years Full-Time

 Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades Filip or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language and Mathematics AND two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A'Level subjects.

NOTE: Departmental requirements apply for B.Sc. Social Work (2 references, a personal statement, co-curricular form and or interview).

Four Years Part-Time

 Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level / BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) with compulsory English Language and Mathematics.



FACULTY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES

Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (M.B,B.S.) / Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.) / Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M) Five Years Full-Time (applicants must be at least 18 years old in the year of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Levels/ BGCSE (Grades A-C) in English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics AND three double Units CAPE subjects or 3 A'Level subjects including Chemistry, Biology and any other subject.
 - NOTE: Physics and Mathematics are compulsory at the CSEC/BGCSE level, whereas Biology and Chemistry are compulsory at CAPE/A'Levels.
 - OR UWI introductory year in Science & Technology courses in Biology, Chemistry and one other subject.
 - OR Triple Major Associate from an approved community college degree majoring in Biology, Chemistry and one other subject with GPA greater
 - OR Equivalent qualifications (as determined from transcripts).

Non-academic considerations

- All candidates are required to submit a short autobiographic sketch outlining the reasons for their career choice (300 words or less). Candidates must also produce evidence of their involvement in relevant extra-curricular/co-curricular activities, socially-oriented projects and voluntary community service in the year prior to their application.
- D.D.S. applicants are required to attend an interview either face-to-face or via Skype.
- Submit Work Observation Form.

Entry Level Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD)

Five Years Full-Time (applicants must be at least 18 years old in year of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics AND three double Units CAPE subjects or 3 A'Level subjects in Biology, Chemistry and Mathematics or Physics. Applicants will be required to attend an interview, either in person or via Skype.
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals who can attest to the candidate's character, scientific ability and work experience.

B.Sc. Diagnostic Imaging (Radiography) Three Years Full-Time

- Six CSEC subjects, (General Proficiency Grades I-III or equivalents) in English Language, Mathematics, Physics, Biology or Human and Social Biology, and two other subjects including a science subject.
- Physics is a compulsory subject for entry to the Diagnostic Imaging (Radiography) programme.
- · Applicant is required to attend an interview.

B.Sc. Nursing

Four Years Full-Time (applicants should be at least 17 years old at the time of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Biology/ Human and Social Biology, Mathematics and two other approved subjects AND two double Units at CAPE (one subject from Mathematics, Physics, Biology, and one subject from any of the other subject areas, as specified by the Nursing Council of Jamaica).
- · Applicants may be required to attend an interview.

B.Sc. Physical Therapy

Three Years Full-Time (applicants should be at least 18 years old at the time of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics and Biology AND two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 A'Level subjects, chosen from Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology,
- Complete 60 voluntary hours in a physical therapy facility at the time of admission; at least 30 of which must be spent in a general hospital. Candidate must make their own arrangements for doing voluntary hours. Applicant must attend an interview.

Bachelor of Basic Medical Sciences (BB MedSci)

Three Years Full-Time (Options: Anatomy, Biochemistry, Physiology and Pharmacology)

- Five CSEC (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) in English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics AND two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 A'Level subjects chosen from Chemistry, Biology/Zoology, Physics/Mathematics.
 - OR UWI Preliminary Science & Technology Courses Chemistry, Life Sciences, Physics, Mathematics.
 - OR . Equivalent qualifications (as determined from transcripts).

NOTE: Students registered in the Bachelor of Basic Medical Sciences Programme cannot transfer to the MB,BS Programme. However, on completion can apply to the MB,BS Programme where credits may be granted.





FACULTY OF SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

(B.Sc.

Three Years Full-Time

 Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics, and at least two approved laboratory science subjects AND two double Units CAPE or 2 GCE A'Level subjects chosen from Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Mathematics, Physics and Computer Science.

Four Years Full-Time (Preliminary Level)

 Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Levels/BGCSE (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics, and at least two approved laboratory science subjects. Special Departmental Requirements (in addition to requirements above)

Actuarial Science

 Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Mathematics AND two double Units CAPE in Mathematics and one other subject with highly competitive grades.



FACULTY OF SPORT

(B.Sc.)

Three Years Full-Time OR Four Years Part-Time

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language and Mathematics AND two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A'Level subjects.
- Candidates with qualifications other than those listed above will be assessed on a case by case basis.



INSTITUTE FOR GENDER & DEVELOPMENT STUDIES

(B.Sc.)

Three Years Full-Time

 Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language and AND two double Units CAPE subjects or 2 GCE A'Level subjects.

Four Years Part-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) with compulsory English Language.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

English Language is compulsory for admission to all programmes of The University of the West Indies. Candidates who do not possess a Grade I in CSEC English A, a Grade A in GCE O'Level / BGCSE English Language, Grade I or II in CAPE Communication Studies or a Grade A in the GCE General Paper, are required to take an English Language Proficiency Test on entry.

Applicants whose first language is not English must perform satisfactorily in an approved English Language Test, such as the Test of English for Foreign Language (TOEFL). For information of TOEFL please visit www.toefl.org.

OTHER ACCEPTABLE QUALIFICATIONS

Associate degree from approved Caribbean tertiary level institutions with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and above are considered as having satisfied normal matriculation requirements for entry to certain faculties. In specific instances credit/exemptions may be given in respect of Level 1 courses. A higher GPA is required in order to obtain CR/Exemption based on A.Sc degrees.
