

## Program Description

The course is designed specifically for persons who have completed undergraduate degrees in other fields but wish to either transition into the computing field or add computing to their range of skills.

The programme will be offered in an accelerated format over one academic year (3 semesters). Courses will be offered in pairs (two at a time), over a period of eight (8) weeks. Each eight week period is broken down as follows:

- Two (2) 4-hour sessions per week over a period of six (6) weeks— (ONE 4 hour period for EACH of the two courses being offered in the eight week period
- 2-week break
- examinations for the two courses at the end of the 2-week break
- 1-week break between the examinations and then the start of the next 2 courses

Classes are held in the evenings (2 evenings per week), making it a perfect option for working professionals.

## Criteria for Graduation

To graduate a student must complete a total of 32 credits as follows:

- A core of six courses (Including Individual Project) for 24 credits
- Two elective for 8 credits
