Post Graduate Diploma in Loss Grief and Trauma Management

Targeting:



This graduate diploma aims to equip health professionals and service providers with specialist training in grief and trauma counselling to improve the lives of children and adults who experience loss.



Structure of Programme:

- ⇒ Duration of programme is one year, beginning in September
- ⇒ Online lectures and face to face weekend classes allow students to work full-time while studying
- ⇒ Ten modules: one month duration each
- ⇒ Core and optional modules include:
 - ◆ Normal and complicated grief
 - ◆ Interventions working with trauma,
 - ◆ Parent-child separation (incarceration, migration, death)
 - ◆ Group/Crisis intervention

Application Requirements:

- Applicants should have a graduate degree in counselling or a related field.
