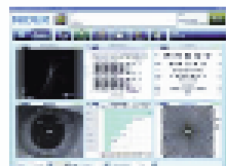

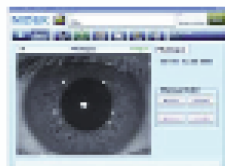

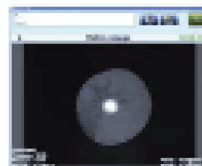
Toric IOL Summary
