COURSE ASSESSMENT

1. WRITTEN EXAMINATION = 60% of final mark

This is a two-hour examination and candidates write three answers. The examination paper has six questions.

2. COURSEWORK = 40% of final mark.

This comprises two parts:

(a) an **in-course test** worth 20% of the final mark This will be a one-hour test paper consisting of short questions designed to test knowledge and concepts learnt from lectures in the first half of the course.

DATE: The coursework test will be held on **Tuesday 7th March**, between 9.00am and 10.00am in Lab 2. Last year's paper will be made available for inspection from the departmental office two weeks before the date of the test.

(b) an **internet-based research project** which will involve the compilation and submission of a project report. The assignment will be undertaken during the second half of the semester, and the submission of the report will be timed towards the end of the semester, at a date to be announced later. The report will be graded and is worth 20% of the final mark. The details of the project will be discussed in a special project briefing class after the coursework test.
