

*Foreign Language Requirement

Students are required to take Part I and Part II of the same language as determined by the Foreign Languages Department (see below guidelines). It is important to note that the basic component for any of the languages (e.g. FREN0001 or SPAN001, etc.) does not satisfy the Foreign Language requirement.

Spanish:

- **Without CSEC** - SPAN0101 (Sem. I) & SPAN1000 (Sem. II)
- **With CSEC** - SPAN1000 (Sem. I) & SPAN1001 (Sem. II)
- **With CAPE** - SPAN1001 (Sem. I) & SPAN1002 (Sem. II)

French:

- **Without CSEC** - FREN0101 (Sem. I) & FREN1000 (Sem. II)
- **With CSEC** - FREN1000 (Sem. I) & FREN1001 (Sem. II)
- **With CAPE** - FREN1001 (Sem. I) & FREN1002 (Sem. II) OR FREN1199 (a 6-credit course combining FREN1001 & FREN1002 offered in Summer School)

Chinese: CHIN1001 (Sem. I) & CHIN1002 (Sem. II)

Japanese: JAPA1001 (Sem. I) & JAPA1002 (Sem. II)

Portuguese: PORT0101 (Sem. I) & PORT0102 (Sem. II)

* Students must have completed all Level I IR and Semester 1 Level II courses. * A student who has done GOVT3051 is not eligible for selection to do GOVT3056. * GOVT3056 is offered to the top 25 finalizing, full-time IR Major students based on the degree GPA and subject to availability of suitable placements. * Students are usually notified of their selection for the internship in Semester 2 of Level II and provided with further details by the programme coordinator. * The Internship is usually done over a 4-week period during the summer months.
