The Department of Microbiology is one of the eight departments in the Faculty of Medical Sciences (FMS), at the UWI, Mona Campus. The Department offers undergraduate and postgraduate training in the subspecialties of Bacteriology, Virology, Mycology, Immunology and Parasitology. It conducts research in various areas covered by its subspecialties and also provides laboratory diagnostic services to the University Hospital of the West Indies and a number of private entities.

The successful candidate will be required to:

- Teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Immunology, take part in curriculum development, be involved in interdisciplinary collaboration, develop innovative research, and participate in the supervision and training of postgraduate students.
- Make a significant contribution to the department's research output, undertake an appropriate teaching and administrative load, and participate in campus-related and external outreach activities.
- Lead an active, extramurally funded program in immunology
- Actively contribute to the development of clinical immunology through research and service

Essential qualification and experience:

- Terminal degree (PhD, DM, DPhil, or other) in Medical Microbiology with specialist training in Immunology
- Evidence of research in immunology
- Teaching experience at the tertiary level
- A record of publication in high impact factor journals

Candidates who possess the following will be at a distinct advantage:

- Certificate in University Teaching;
- Experience supervising MPhil/PhD students;
- Evidence of prior grant acquisition;
- Administrative Experience within an Academic Institution;
- Evidence of Curriculum Development (face to face or distant delivery modes);

- Possess a research record commensurate to academic career as demonstrated by publications in peer reviewed journals with appreciable impact factors.
