INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

At the University of the West Indies, students are encouraged to spend a semester or a year (except the final semester of the final year) at any of our partner universities in the USA, Canada, Asia, Europe, South Pacific or South America at no additional tuition cost.

Tuition fees are paid to the UWI and not to the host university under exchange agreements; however, you are responsible for your living, transportation and other expenses.

You may also opt to spend a semester or a year at another UWI campus:

- The Cave Hill Campus in Barbados
- or The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad & Tobago

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Caribbean Integration Programme (CIP) is a bursary available to students participating in the intercampus exchange to the Cave Hill or St. Augustine Campuses.

The Canada-CARICOM and Emerging Leaders in the Americas Programme (ELAP) scholarships are available to both undergraduate and graduate students participating in exchange to one of the UWI's Canadian partners.

STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMME

JAMA

All universities abroad are open to UWI students willing to pay tuition and all other costs to the host university.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To go on exchange you must complete the appropriate application forms, and if required submit a statement/reason for choosing the host university to the International Students Office (ISO).

Consult with, and request approval from, your Head of Department and Dean of Faculty for courses you must complete at the overseas university. Then submit your application forms by the deadline.

ELIGIBILITY

To satisfy the requirements for the International Exchange or Study Abroad Programme, you should:

- Be registered as a full time student;
- Have completed at least one academic year at UWI;
- Have attained at least a GPA of 3.0; and,
- Have no disciplinary action pending.
