UWI Libraries' Information Connexion (UWIIInC) is the new information portal for the Libraries at the UWI. Through this portal library users are now able to access resources in a variety of formats from a single web interface from all four campuses (Cave Hill, St Augustine, Open Campus and Mona).

These include:

- Printed and electronic resources from the online public access catalogues (OPACs) of the four UWI campuses
- Electronic resources such as journal
 articles and electronic books from
 databases
- Digital content from the libraries
 digital repositories: UWISPACE and
 Mona Digital Collection
- Selected free electronic resources

Off campus access is available via the sign-in feature. Users are allowed to save searches, add reviews, tag and retrieve results using their own terms, filter results by resource type, collection, language, relevance, date and more.
