

Students Advance to the Final Round

The Department of Mathematics at the UWI, Mona Campus, has completed the assessment of the Semifinal Round Examination in the 2015 Jamaican Mathematical Olympiad. This examination was held on February 28 at the UWI, Mona, and at Herbert Morrison Technical High School. The Olympiad Organizing Committee has determined that 134 students will advance to the Final Round. These students come from a total of 30 high schools in Jamaica.

The Final Round consists of two events. The first is a problem-solving workshop for all advancing students. This will be held on Saturday, March 21, simultaneously at the UWI, Mona Campus, and at Herbert Morrison Technical High School in Montego Bay. The second event is the Final Round Examination. This **will be held on Saturday, March 28, at the UWI, Mona Campus, only**. The examination for students in Grades 7 and 8 will last for two and one-half hours. The Examination for students in Grades 9, 10, and 11 will last for three hours. More information for each school is given in a separate posting called "Guidelines for Final Round Students".

The Semifinal Round Examination was held on February 28 in two locations: The UWI, Mona Campus, and Herbert Morrison Technical High School in Montego Bay. A total of 360 students from 51 high schools in Jamaica sat this exam.
