

Frequently asked questions

(Returning students)

I am trying to register for advanced courses, however the system is saying I don't have the pre-requisites, what do I do?

ANSWER

If you are trying to register and can confirm you have the prerequisites, request an override for approval

Having completed year 1, I wasn't successful with all my level 1 courses. Can I still register for level 2 courses while repeating the level 1 courses I failed?

ANSWER

YES YOU CAN. However, the department would only be willing to allow this if you have successfully passed 3 out of the required 4. Anything less would need to special permission from the Undergraduate Coordinator (S.A.M. email: sam.mcdaniel@uwimona.edu.jm) BEFORE CONSIDERATION CAN BE HAD.

I wasn't accepted to the BSc Actuarial Science programme in year 1 can I now go ahead and add this option to my page for approval.

ANSWER

No, your transcript will need to be reviewed for consideration and as such contact must be made with the Director of the Programme – Mr. Howard Hines email: howard.hines@uwimona.edu.jm – for his review.

I made a request for override, however I am not seeing where it was approved, what do I do?

ANSWER

Make contact with the department if the period of non-approval is more than 2 weeks. You can email them at maths@uwimona.edu.jm with the details. Ensure that your UWI ID# is also enclosed in the body of the mail.

I want to register for a course that is not seen on my list of free electives, can I do so?

ANSWER

It's not advisable that you do so. Permission must be sought from the Department (senior member of staff and or the programme coordinator) before doing so.

I failed a course last academic year, can I register for 'exams only' during the semester?

ANSWER

No, 'Exams only' are only granted through summer school. You can however register for the full course for re-sit during the respective semester if it is available.
