### Overview:

In any organization the finance function plays a key role in developing business and determining service or product costs. Proper financial management assists the organization to effectively and efficiently utilize its limited resources to achieve its objectives. Non-financial officers are also involved in managing finance for their business functions, hence the need for them to acquire the requisite financial skills. This course aims to equip the non-financial officers with knowledge in core financial principles and improve their financial decision making in this ever changing business environment.
