• What is Executive Education, and how does it differ from regular degree programs?

The Executive Education prgrams/courses offered by the Mona School of Business & Management (MSBM) are short-term, non-degree courses designed for working professionals seeking to enhance their skills, knowledge, and leadership capabilities. Please note that the decision on whether to grant exemptions would be at the discretion of the University, and they would be able to provide you with specific information regarding this matter.

• What is the refund policy in case I need to withdraw from an Executive Education program?

Our cancellation, withdrawal and refund policy is as follows: MSBM/PSU reserves the right to cancel any course and will refund 100% of fees paid. Participants who cancel their attendance in a course five (5) business days or more before the start of the course will be refunded 95% of the fee. MSBM will charge a processing fee of 30% of the course fee per person for all cancellations received less than 5 business days prior to the start of the course. No refund will be given once the person has attended the first class. All cancellations must be in writing. Registration is transferable where the registered person is unable to attend, and makes the request in writing. In all refund cases above, payment will be refunded once a written request is submitted.

Notable partnerships include those with organizations such as the Project Management Institute, the International Institute of Business Analysis, and the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals.
