IUMP Caribbean Launch

Jump is an initiative developed to foster greater digital inclusion across Jamaica. The Jump program was designed to create a more inclusive digital society by providing subsidized internet connections, a compatible device (laptop/tablet) and digital literacy training for those families most in need supported by subsidies provided by funding partners.

MSBM through its Caribbean School of Data initiative continues to be the strategic partner of choice for the digital skills component of the program. The JUMP Regional initiative was launched in Barbados on June 10, 2023, the CSOD was represented by Dr. Maurice McNaughton, Director COE, MSBM.

The JUMP Programme in partnership with FLOW Foundation / Cable Wireless which involves the provision of Broadband internet access, digital devices and digital literacy skills training to marginalized households (1500 PATH beneficiaries in Jamaica) is being extended to four (4) additional countries in the Caribbean: Barbados, St. Lucia, Grenada and Bahamas.

MSBM Commits \$1M to FSS Free Likkle Cupboard Initiative

The Faculty of Social Sciences (FSS) launched an initiative to provide food and personal care items for students in need. This initiative came out of the realization that many students were struggling in the current socioeconomic climate and as such were finding it difficult to obtain sufficient nutrition.


As a means to addressing this problem, FSS partnered with the local NGO, the Free Likkle Cupboard (FLC). The Free Likkle Cupboard initiative was started in 2020 by De-Andrea Jackson and Kyle Reynolds who wanted to create a culture of people giving back with a view to helping those in need.

"MSBM believes that this is a noble and well needed venture which will benefit students in the faculty in a very meaningful way," said Dr. David McBean, Executive Director, MSBM.

He continued "To that end we wish to formally indicate our support for

the FSS Food Cupboard. MSBM will commit the sum of One Million Dollars Jamaican Dollars (J\$1,000,000.00) to purchase items for the Food Cupboard over a ten month period for the academic year 2023/2024."
