ICJS UWI Peace Poster Competition Rules

Theme: "CLIMATE ACTION FOR PEACE"

1. All submissions must be sent via email to: uwi4peace@uwimona.edu.jm
2. Submissions must include: A completed entry form along with artwork.
3. Posters should be 11in. x 17in. (landscape or portrait) in size and submitted in **jpeg** or **PNG** format.
4. **Open to all enrolled tertiary students within the Caribbean.**
5. Employees of ICJS-UWI, their immediate family members, and competition sponsors are not eligible.
6. The Institute of Criminal Justice and Security reserves the right to disqualify any poster that does not meet the requirements specified in these instructions. Entries with plagiarised content will be rejected.
7. ICJS-UWI does not accept any responsibility for late or lost entries due to Internet or email problems. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt. You will receive a confirmation notice once your email has been received. Entrants must supply full details as required and comply with all rules to be eligible for the prizes.
8. While the entrants retain copyright in their posters, they agree to permit ICJS-UWI to use the posters for promotional and other purposes in connection with this Competition. Acknowledgement of the entrants will be given where possible.
9. This competition is promoted by ICJS-UWI. ICJS-UWI reserves the right to cancel the competition at any stage if deemed necessary and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
10. By submitting an entry, the entrant signifies his agreement with and acceptance of the rules of this Competition.
11. **Cash prizes will be paid directly to the tertiary institution to which the student is enrolled.**
12. Entries will be **blind-judged** by a panel of ICJS-UWI officials and climate change and visual arts professionals, **i.e.** judges are not aware of any information about the authorship of entries or location of entrants. Entries will be evaluated based on appeal, theme-inclusion and content.
13. All winners will be notified via email. Entrants are responsible for providing valid contact information and for checking their respective email accounts for notifications regarding the Poster Competition. If a potential winner does not respond within five (5) calendar days of the first notification attempt – or if the prize notification is returned as unclaimed or undeliverable – the potential winner will forfeit his/her prize and ICJS-UWI will select an alternate winner from the remaining eligible entries.
14. **Prizes will be awarded for the two top entries.** First place winner will receive US\$1,000.00 towards tuition or university/college accommodation. Second place winner will receive US\$500.00 towards tuition or university/college housing. Photos and accompanying news release will be posted on the UWI website and ICJS social media pages.
15. Decisions are final. ICJS-UWI reserves the right to reject all submissions.
