

ENTRY REQUIREMENTSFaculty of Engineering

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc. Engineering)

Three Years Full-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics AND two double Units CAPE or two GCE A Level passes in Pure/Pure & Applied Mathematics and Physics OR Equivalent qualifications from approved tertiary institution. Biology at any level could be an advantage for Biomedical Engineering.

NOTE: Holders of Associate degrees or diplomas from approved Caribbean tertiary level institutions must possess a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.5 or 65% and above.

Two Years (Teacher Trained) Full-Time or Three Years Part-Time. Must possess Teachers & College Certificate in relevant area + four CXC grades (I-III)/ GCE (A-C) including English Language

OR

Multi-Modal/In-Service Study- in any of the following disciplines: Mathematics Education, English Language Education, Science Education and Social Studies/Geography Education.

Must be employed at the Secondary level in the desired area of study and possess a Teachers' College Diploma in relevant area + CSEC/GCE' O'level English Language and three other CSEC Subjects.

Three Years Full-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) including English Language AND two double Units CAPE subjects or two GCE A-Level subjects (one of which must be a Humanities subject for which courses are taught at the University). A pass in a foreign language, at least at the CSEC Level/O'Level, is strongly recommended.



Three Years Full-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O'Level /BGCSE su jects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language AND three (3) double Units CAPE subjects or three (3) GCE A Level.

There are no special subject requirements in addition to those necessary for Matriculation. However, successful entrants typically have much higher qualifications since entry is competitive.

Selection for admission into the Faculty of Law is based on a points system.

NOTE: Departmental requirements apply for B.Sc. Social Work (2 references, personal statement, co-curricular form and/or interview).

Four Years Part-Time

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) or GCE O'Level / BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) with compulsory English Language and Mathematics.



Five years Full-Time (applicants must be at least 18 years old in year of admission)

Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O Levels/ BGCSE (Grades A-C) in English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemis-

try and Physics AND three double Units CAPE subjects or three A- Level subjects including Chemistry, Biology and any other subject.

NOTE: Physics and Mathematics are compulsory at the CSEC/BGCSE level, whereas Biology and Chemistry are compulsory at CAPE/A-Levels

OR

UWI introductory year in Science & Technology Courses in Biology, Chemistry and one other

OR

Triple Major Associate from an approved community colleges degree majoring in Biology, Chemistry and one other subject with GPA greater than 3.5.

OP

Equivalent qualifications (as determined from transcripts).

Non-Academic Considerations

- All candidates are required to submit a short autobiographic sketch outlining the reasons for their career choice (300 words or less) Candidates must also produce evidence of their involvement in relevant extra-curricular/co-curricular activities, socially-oriented projects and voluntary community service in the year prior to their application.
- DDS applicants are required to attend an interview
- Submit Work Observation Form

Entry Level Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD)

Five Years Full-Time (applicants must be at least 18 years old in year of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics AND 3 double Units CAPE subjects or 3 A- Level subjects in Biology, Chemistry and Mathematics or Physics.
- Applicants will be required to attend an interview.
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals who can attest to the candidate's character, scientific ability and work experience

B.Sc. Diagnostic Imaging (Radiography) - Three years Full-Time

- Six CSEC subjects, (General Proficiency Grades I-III or equivalents) in English Language, Mathematics, Physics, Biology or Human and Social Biology, and two other subjects including a science subject.
- Physics is a compulsory subject for entry to the Diagnostic Imaging (Radiography) programme.
- Applicants are required to attend an interview.

B.Sc. Nursing - Four Years Full-Time (applicants should be at least 17 years old at the time of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) which must include English Language, Biology/ Human andSocial Biology, Mathematics and two other approved subjects AND Two double Units at CAPE (one subject from Mathematics, Physics, Biology, and one subject fromany of the other subject areas, as specified by the Nursing Council of Jamaica).
- Applicants are required to attend an interview.



Faculty of Medical Sciences Contd.

B.Sc. Physical Therapy - Three Years Full-Time (applicants should be at least 18 years old at time of admission)

- Five CSEC subjects (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O Level /BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) whicah must include English Language, Mathematics and Biology AND Two double Units CAPE subjects or two A- Level subjects, chosen from Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology.
- Complete 60 voluntary hours in a physical therapy facility at the time of admission, at least 30 of which must be spent in a general hospital. Candidate must make their own arrangements for doing voluntary hours
- Applicant are required to attend an interview.

Bachelor of Basic Medical Sciences (BBMedSci) Three years Full-Time

(Options: Anatomy, Biochemistry, Physiology and Pharmacology)

- Five CSEC (General Proficiency Grades I-III) and/or GCE O
 Level/BGCSE subjects (Grades A-C) in English Language,
 Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics AND two double
 Units CAPE subjects or two A- Level subjects chosen from
 Chemistry, Biology/Zoology, Physics/Mathematics
- OR UWI preliminary Science and Technology courses:
 Chemistry, Life Sciences, Physics, Mathematics
 - **OR** Equivalent qualifications (as determined from transcripts).

NOTE: Students registered in the Bachelor of Basic Medical Sciences Programme cannot transfer to the M.B.B.S Programme. However, on completion they can apply to the M.B.B.S. Programme where credits may be granted.



English language:

English Language is compulsory for admission to all programmes of The University of the West Indies. Candidates who do not possess a Grade I in CSEC English A, a Grade A in GCE O'Level / BGCSE English Language, Grade I or II in CAPE Communication Studies or a Grade A in the GCE General Paper, are required to take an English Language Proficiency Test on entry.

Applicants whose first language is not English must perform satisfactorily in an approved English Language Test, such as the Test of English for Foreign Language (TOEFL). For information of TOEFL please visit www.toefl.org

Foreign Language Requirement:

All students who have been accepted into The University of the West Indies to read for an undergraduate degree are required to register for and successfully complete a prescribed three-credit foreign language course at the level of their competence.

"Foreign Language" encompasses all languages, including Creole of the Caribbean



Exemptions:

Students who matriculated into The University with a foreign language obtained at the Caribbean Examinations Council with CSEC (Grade I,II or III) or CAPE Unit I or II (Grades I to V) or an equivalent, will be exempted from this requirement.

All international students whose first language is not English and who matriculated into the University with English as a Second Language qualification will be also be exempted from this requirement.

Other Acceptable Qualifications:

An Associate degree from an approved Caribbean tertiary level institution with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and above are considered as having satisfied normal matriculation requirements for entry to certain faculties.

In specific instances credit/exemptions may be given in respect of Level 1 courses. A higher GPA is required in order to obtain Credit/Exemption based on Associate degrees.
