WORK OF THE DEPARTMENT

The mission of the Department of Basic Medical Sciences (BMS) is to be committed to the promotion of excellence in teaching and research and to the creation of an environment which fosters growth and development among its students and staff. In pursuance of the University's Strategic Plan, our vision is to strive for excellence in curriculum delivery (graduate formation), scholarship and service. However, we recognize several risks (classified as moderate to high) in achieving these, inter alia, lack of funding (High); improving quality of teaching, research/innovation and student development (moderate to high); ability to achieve Agility Goal 4 (of being a "Creative. Caring, Accountable, Motivated and Professional (CAMP) Team" (Moderate to High); and growth of academic-industry research partnership (Moderate).

During the year, the governance structure was further tweaked with the appointment of Dr. Paul Singh (BBMedSc coordinator) as Head of Section for the new Section, Pharmacology and Pharmacy. Thanks was expressed to Dr. Gossell-Williams, who had served for many years. We were pleased with the approval of the revised BSc Physical Therapy curriculum, and look forward to the completion of the revised BBMedSc curriculum. Further, courses delivered in the MSc Sports Medicine and MSc Sports and Exercise Medicine-Physiotherapy programmes were transferred to the Mona Academy of Sport.

Research in BMS is diverse and highly specialized in disciplines and subdisciplines, and while there are some research/thematic groups in Biochemistry, Forensic Sciences and Physiology, there are few crossdisciplinary research projects, such as Cannabis and hypertension. Given the almost even split between full-time regular and temporary academic staff, there continues to be a heavy burden on the former to deliver even more.

Notwithstanding the challenges, there are numerous examples of excellence, and many of these are highlighted in the report. However, we single out the announcement of the national honour to be bestowed on Mr. Mike Gardner (Order of Distinction, Commander Class). Heartiest congratulations.

Further, the contributions of those who have served in the department and had retired were celebrated in a first Retirees' luncheon held at Waterfalls Restaurant. By all indications, it was well received by the retirees.
