Programme Note:

- a) Students are urged to check the current handbook for additional programme requirements and departmental guidelines.
- b) FOUN1013 or FOUN1019 must be completed in the first year of entry.
- c) Students who are exempt (without credit) from taking the Foreign Language course must substitute it with a level 1 free elective.
- d) Students have the option to take both FOUN1101 and FOUN1201 to meet their Level free elective requirements.
- e) Students are urged to read Part III of the current Undergraduate Handbook for details on the Foreign Language Policy and Requirements.
- f) Part-time students must take PSYC1000, SOCI1002, SOWK1001, FOUN1013 (or FOUN1019), SOWK1010 and SOWK1003 in their first year.
- g) The Social Work Practicum places students on working assignments in social work and social service agencies. The Practicum represents an integral part of the course of study and part-time students also need to meet the requirement for agency visits and field placement. The year I practicum comprises 165 hours while years II and III involve 266 and 320 hours of practicum time, respectively.
