



DEGREE PLANNING CHECKLIST

The degree planning checklist is a resource designed to assist FSS students in (i) tracking their rate of progress and programme requirements, (ii) undertaking a credit check, and (iii) seeking academic advising from their Department/School in a timely manner. It is not intended as the official confirmation of a student's eligibility to graduate. It is important to note that students must obtain a GPA of 2.0 or higher in addition to at least 90 credits to graduate. The programme requirements below are applicable ONLY for the following major and year of admission/readmission/transfer/change of major.
