



DEGREE PLANNING CHECKLIST

Programme Notes:

In addition to the above requirements, students are required to register for three (3) internships during the summer term (semester 3) of each academic year. These zero-credit courses are MGMT1424, MGMT2124 and MGMT3124. See handbook for recommended electives.

* Students must take the appropriate qualifying language course to meet the level II/III Foreign Language requirement. Students without a grade 2 pass in a language at CSEC must do SPAN0101 or FREN0101 or CHIN1001 or JAPA1001, however, these zero-credit courses will not satisfy the Level I foreign language requirement above. Students who have achieved a grade 2 pass at CSEC in a language must do two level 1 free electives. Students who have achieved a grade 3 pass at CSEC are exempted from the qualifying language course, however, they must complete the next appropriate language level.

** Students must complete second language course in sequence from previously done language course (appropriate proficiency) i.e., SPAN2008 or FREN1000 or CHIN2001 or JAPA2001. Students who have achieved a grade 3 or no pass at CSEC in languages must, complete one of the language courses above.
