PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The Doctor of Education (EdD) programme is a professional qualification, targeting graduates with a Master's degree or other professionals who are seeking to acquire advanced competencies in the field of education. This programme is suited for persons who wish to position themselves to serve in various leadership capacities in the education sector. The EdD programme will provide competencies to enable candidates to :

- Develop educational strategic plans
- Assess the feasibility and sustainability of externally funded educational projects
- Manage international education development programmes
- Develop, implementing and evaluating educational policy
- Conduct economic and impact analyses of educational programmes
- Manage higher educational institutions
- Provide leadership in promoting collaboration among higher education institutions
- Develop and evaluating national educational curricula
- Design strategies for improving teacher education
- Design strategies to improve pedagogy
- Develop solutions for dealing with major problems facing the education sector
- Advance testing and measurement techniques and technologies

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ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission, applicants must:

- Be graduates of a recognized training institution, college, or university with at least a Master's degree
- Have at least 5 years' experience working in the fields of education, training, social development, or related fields
- Be interviewed by a panel comprising representatives from the School of Education.

DELIVERY FORMAT

Blended delivery (in-person and on-line classes).

DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

The programme will take a minimum of 4 years to complete. All students will register part-time and will be expected to do, on average, 9 credits per semester. Students may, however, do a further 3 credits with permission from the Programme Coordinator.

TUITION COST

The cost of the programme is **USD \$300** per credit or **USD \$18,900.00** to pursue the programme over the four years.

SPECIALIZATIONS

The programme is designed to accommodate several concentrations which will be developed on an ongoing basis to respond to global, regional, and national market demands. For 2021/2022, the programme will begin with the **Educational Planning and Social Development** specialization. Thereafter, other specializations will be available to incoming students.
