

PROGRAMME OFFERINGS

FACULTY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES

B. Sc. Medicine and Surgery (MBBS)

The MBBS programme is a medical undergraduate programme providing education for the study of health and disease. In addition to the training, students experience university life and the beginnings of professional development in preparation for a career in medicine.

PROGRAMME REQUIREMENTS

Normal Matriculation (Full-time)

AT LEAST five(5) CXC/CSEC subjects (general proficiency) Grades I-III or the equivalent, including Biology, Physics, Chemistry, English Language and Mathematics AND AT LEAST three (3) CAPE subjects (both units) /three (3) A-levels including Biology, Physics (or Mathematics) and any other subject(s)
This programme is only offered full-time.

B. Sc. Nursing (Generic)

Candidates successfully completing this BScN programme will be eligible to apply to sit the Regional Examination for Nurse Registration (RENr). This will enable the individual to practice nursing in Jamaica and other CARICOM countries.

PROGRAMME REQUIREMENTS

Normal Matriculation (Full-time)

AT LEAST five(5) CXC/CSEC subjects (general proficiency) Grades I-III or the equivalent, including Biology/Human and Social Biology/Integrated Science, English Language and Mathematics
AND

AT LEAST two (2) CAPE subjects (both units) /two(2) A-levels including Biology, and any other subject(s)

This programme is only offered full-time.

CARIMAC: The Caribbean Institute of Media and Communication (CARIMAC) is a unit of the Faculty of Humanities and Education that provides professional training in media and communication, digital media production, and journalism.

B.A. Integrated Marketing Communication

B.A. Digital Media Production

(offered at the Western Jamaica Campus only): The purpose of this degree is to meet an increasing demand in the media and communication services for specific and focused skills.

Lower Level Matriculation (Part-time)

Five (5) CSEC/CXC subjects (Gen. Proficiency)
Grades 1-3 or its equivalent, including English Language and Mathematics.

PROGRAMME OFFERINGS

FACULTY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

B. Sc. Actuarial Science:

This is a discipline that uses mathematics and statistical models to assess and manage risk and to solve financial and social problems. Graduates in this field apply their skills to calculations in life, health, social, and casualty insurance, annuities and pensions.

B. Sc. Information Technology:

This programme aims to address the needs of the Caribbean region and produce graduates who have been exposed to experiences that will prepare them to address the information processing requirements of organizations.

B. Sc. Mathematics:

This degree looks at topics in Mathematics, from pure mathematics to how mathematics is used in real-life situations.

L.L.B. (Bachelor of Laws)

First year only: The Bachelor of Laws programme is a three-year degree programme that provides the perfect foundation for students pursuing law as a profession. After acquiring the L.L.B., students will then move on to law school to complete training, or can go on to pursue any other career in the legal profession.

PROGRAMME REQUIREMENTS

Normal Matriculation (Full-time)

AT LEAST five(5) CXC/CSEC subjects (general proficiency) Grades I-III or the equivalent, including English Language AND AT LEAST two (2) CAPE subjects (both units) /two(2) A-levels. This degree is only offered full-time.
